Remark 1: The given value of the fee is valid for invoicing of advance fee for the given period and includes the treatment contribution (PN) and operational contribution (PP)

Remark 2: According to the § 37n, par 3 of the Act on Waste, the possibility to show the fee for historical EEE (PHE) visibly was terminated on 13 August 2013, with the exemption of group 1, where the PHE will remain at the value set for 2012.

Remark 3: Fee for PN is not calculated for reported business equipment (B2B)

Remark 4: The administration lump fee 50 CZK per quarter was set for 2015.

Remark 5: Fee for photovoltaic panels do not concern those installed before 1.1.2013, this fee was set at 8,50 CZK/kg by the amended Decree. This amendment sets the obligation to apply the formula in Annex N. 10 also for Producers/Distributors of the panels, whereas it is not necessary to use the minimum rate 8,50 CZK, or 935 CZK/kW. Parameters for the formula might be approved by the Ministry of Environment in the framework for the obligatory justification of compliance of the take-back scheme with the Decree with the deadline of 31. October 2013. Completed documents were handed over to the Ministry of Environment on 27 May 2013 and 15 October 2013. In this line, the minimum amount of the savings on future disposal were set at the level of 1,50 CZK/kg.
